- All Emergency Medicine rotations have shifts assigned at both CAMC-Memorial Hospital and CAMC-General Hospital.
- OB/GYN, Pediatric EM and PICU rotations occur at CAMC-Women and Children’s Hospital.
- PGY2 ICU Selective is either Cardiovascular ICU or Medical ICU.
- EMS shifts include transfer center, ground transport ride-alongs, and optional aeromedical ride-alongs.
- PGY3 Elective is tailored to the interests of the individual resident and includes either further education and training in any of the required rotations or a choice from the following: Anesthesia, EKG, Advanced EMS, EM Administration, Family Practice, General Surgery, Medical Simulation, Neurology, Orthopedics, Radiology, Research, Toxicology, Trauma, Advanced Ultrasound. A resident with interest in an area not listed may work with Program Leadership and GME staff to develop a learning experience.
- Research is not separately dedicated time unless part of an Elective’s objectives. Residents incorporate research and scholarly activities into daily clinical and educational activities.
